

New Aspley shopping village is scheduled to open its doors to the public next month

A \$42 million shopping centre at Robinson Rd, Aspley, will feature the northside's only hydrotherapy medical service. The two-storey Aspley Village development, opening on December 11, includes a Coles supermarket; gourmet fruit, vegetable and produce shop Zone Fresh; Bargain Central, medical centre and 22 speciality shops.

Race Property leasing consultant Graeme Wakefield said the centre's design combined convenient shopping with cafe-style food and beverage services.

Mr Wakefield said the centre also included a state-of-the-art medical centre.

"The 3500sqm medical centre includes hydrotherapy pools - the only on Brisbane's

northside - and all specialist services," he said.

Construction started on the building in January 2008 with many businesses closing and relocating to other premises during this time.

Mr Wakefield said a range of existing tenants would return to the centre including

Aspley Florist, My Style Gifts, Cellarbrations, the pharmacy and newsagent.

"It also has 470 undercover car parks, is convenient to local residents and will allow people to shop and catch up with friends in the same location," Mr Wakefield said.
